

Comments

The online discussion was helpful, but the group ones depended a lot on who was in your group. I feel as if it was more opinionbased than facts and I do not necessarily feel any more educated on policy from the group discussions alone. Without doing the reading, which was not required to do well in the class, I would have felt as if I hadn't learned much

Discussion Boards broadened my knowledge of the subject matter through the perspectives of my peers. I found this very interesting.

The discussion boards really drove the module of discussion. The different perspectives from the other students contributed to understanding the learning objective per week. The utilization of role assignments for the last two weeks really helped in forcing one to assume a role, (such as a policy–maker) that one may not be used to or unsure of how to fufill. This enabled learning and as mentioned before, students were able to view other student's comments and perspectives.

I really enjoyed the discussions every week. They were challenging and made you think outside the box. With an all online class, this was really helpful for engaging with the other classmates without being physically together.

Students were engaged throughout the semester in writing a policy report on a health policy topic of their choosing.

Both recorded lectures and discussion boards broadened my knowledge regarding policy (which I knew literally nothing about) a lot. I found Dr. A's recorded lectures engaging and interesting. She was able to explain complex topics in a concise, easily understandable way.

I particularly liked the small group discussion boards where each member played a specific role!

I thoroughly enjoyed this class and how engaging everyone was. The professor did a wonderful job being flexible and a helping hand for everyone.

I appreciate the instructor being intensely involved in my learning.

When starting the class the amount of time expected to put into the class was overwhelming and the amount of discussion posts required and how they had to be on so many different days was very daunting. However, halfway through the class things changed and were much more manageable.

This was a great experience as health policy has not been my strong suit. I have come from strong clinical background, grounded in evidence–based practice which to me was a culture shock learning to explain to policy–makers other factors going into a policy or specific clinical guideline to convince one to implement. I was staunchly against having to explain reasons other than the best available evidence to guide policy. However, learning that this is part of the policy–making process, prepares me to be more emotionally intelligent and to truly show evidence from all the different angles and realms. Not just from evidence but from the anecdotal testimonies and fiscal benefits as well. At the end of this course I feel more confident to initiate a process of inquiring about a specific policy or the formation of a new one.

I thoroughly enjoyed this course. I thought the discussion board topics were interesting and appropriately challenging. They made you think outside the box. Professor Acquaviva was very kind, super helpful, and a great teacher. The course was very easy to navigate, everything was thought out and clear. I was never confused about the subject matter or what was asked of me.

I was nervous about the 15 page policy report but Professor Acquaviva laid out the course in a way to make sure you stayed on track. It ended up being one of my favorite parts of the course. It was a very challenging assignment and I learned a great deal.

Dr. Acquaviva is a knowledgeable, fair, and passionate educator. She created a welcoming learning environment. You can tell she genuinely cares about her students. I also appreciated her level of organization and the structure of her class.

This class ended up being one of my surprise favorites. The policy report was challenging and required a lot of work but really enhanced my understanding of policy and I learned so much while writing the paper. The insightly and articulate comments on my paper by Dr. A were exceptional and I loved how she reformatted my paper at the end to show me what is possible. She is clearly not only very knowledgeable on policy, she is passionate and it shows. Wonderful teacher.

I had a wonderful experience in the course! The only suggestion I have is to make the grading expectations and rubrics available at the beginning (perhaps in the syllabus). I found it a bit challenging to constantly be searching for assignments' rubrics and/or expectations, so having all of those centralized and set in stone at the beginning of the semester would have been helpful!







I felt that the samples for the policy paper were misleading in that it was a group project that put out the amount of work that expected from one person. I would have liked a less 'pretty' paper to use as a guide for verbiage, as I didn't feel the complete rewriting was as useful and seems to be a lot of extra work for you. I would recommend individualizing the discussion post rubric per module discussion. For instance, the role playing discussion is specific and different from a general topic of discussion to further provide expectation for the student for each different 2-week period. I truly don't have any constructive feedback. I can't think of any time during the course where I felt like something additional or different was needed. It was very easy to navigate the course and understand what was expected of me. Dr. Acquaviva, I can't think of any suggestions to improve this class.
