This course is very applicable to our studies. I found this course very difficult to do in the distance learning format-I believe it is appropriate to our doctorate- the readings were difficult. I perhaps should have "brushed up" on research information to get up to speed before this course.

I did not get feedback on papers and grades in a timely fashion.

Instructors made a major change in the assignment (meta-analysis to systematic review) based, in part, on student feedback. Change was well coordinated and supported by a change in content. Course change was not disruptive.

I understand the rationale for changing the final assignment but I wished we could have left it the way it was.

The course changed direction mid semester and then I could have used more direction on a systematic review, such as discussions on results, impact on clinical practice, etc. I find I learn quite a bit from student and instructors comments.
