




Learning Activities: To what extent did the following learning activities contribute to your learning?






Learning Activities: To what extent did the following learning activities contribute to your learning?

Great experience. Professor Acquaviva was very transparent and supportive throughout the course.


I really gained a deeper knowledge of how nurses can effect change. I was very impressed with this course and it will change the way I practice in the future.



Professor always affirmed different perspectives and advocated for social justice/equity within the course.

Professor Acquaviva assigned roles to students based upon a discussion. This allowed us to try to think from other individuals perspective (such as a Hospital CEO, a Medicaid recipient, a 31 yo stage IV cancer patient). She also mentioned in the first recording her work with LGBTQA community and her passion for policy related to this community. As someone from the LGBTQA community, I found it very welcoming.

Professor Acquaviva was mindful of addressing people by their preferred names and pronouns. She welcomed different perspectives in discussion boards and had us write through different perspectives so we can understand and foster inclusivity.

Dr. Acquaviva always encouraged us to see things from varying perspectives—some of the discussion prompts actually assigned roles to us so that we could view various issues from different viewpoints or stakeholders which was invaluable. She also encouraged our discussion and frequently acknowledged varying viewpoints on hot topics. This is especially important in a class like Policy which can be so politically charged!
